Vetting in: 07.00- 08.30 AM

- All cats must be inoculated against Feline Infectious Enteritis, FHV & FCV (cat flu) by a veterinary surgeon in accordance with each country's veterinary regulations, against panleucopaenia and cat-flu and have had the required boosters, at least 15 days prior to the show.
 The cats have to be vaccinated with boosters at least every second year; the last vaccination has to be given no more than two years (730 days) before the show.
 Foreign Exhibitors: Vaccinated for Rabies according to national rules min 21 days old and Chipped. **foreigners, European passport required**
 White Cats: It is a FIFe rule that no white cat can be accepted at a show without having a certificate of hearing. This Certificate should be shown to the veterinarian when passing through the vetting-in procedure.

FIFe shows have 4 categories:

- Category 1: Persian & Exotic
- Category 2: Semi-Longhair
- Category 3: Shorthair and Somali
- Category 4: Siamese and Oriental (per 1.1.2006) Seychelleois short – longhair
 Extra: Best Housecat & Best Veteran and best Kitten group.

Per category a Best-In-Show will be organised: kitten 3-6 m., junior 6-10 m., neuter female en neuter male; adult female and adult male.

- the BIS election will start around 15.30
- The show ends when the BIS election is completed, around 18.00 hours
- A show has to be a pleasant experience for cat and owner. If your cat doesn't enjoy the show please leave him or her at home.
- Nails should be trimmed one or two days prior to the show
- In 2007 a microchip will become obligatory!
